REPORT 2018-19

The Board of Student Development has been one of the active department in the academic year 2018-19. It has implemented various Development schemes for the overall development of the students of our College. It has been a mediator to communicate various Central and State Government & other schemes to the students. At the same time it has availed information of various scholarship schemes to the students& encourages them for the benefit of such schemes. It has facilitated the participation of students in the intercollegiate and inter-University competitions. At the same time it provides Remedial coaching to the weaker students. It has availed financial support to the students in case of mishap.Thus it has contributed towards total personality development of the students.

The scheme avails job opportunities to the poor and needy students in the College campus itself so that they may secure higher education without economic hurdle. The special feature of the scheme is that it supports students financially and facilitates earning while learning. The focus of the scheme is to enhance the dignity of labour and create work culture among the students.

For the academic year 2018- 19 near about 100 students applied for the enrolment of Earn and Learn Scheme. They were interviewed individually and enrolled for the scheme on the basis of their financial status, availability of jobs and the skill of the students. Accordingly 25 students were enrolled in the scheme. Out of them 25 students were provided jobs in

various departments of the College. The major work was done in Library, Office, Examination section, Garden, book arrangement and numbering, data entry and processing, record keeping, scanning of exam and scholarship forms, office management and also helped the respective departments in the organization of various seminars, conferences and competitions. Students were given access to the computers which motivated computer literacy and other vocational skills among the students.20 Girls students & 05 Boys students were enrolled in the scheme for the year 2018-19. The total 25 students were benefitted by Earn & Learn Scheme.

- The scheme is exclusively implemented for the girl students with the special focus on the personality development of the students so that their morale may boost up. Under this scheme Two days Workshop was organized on 26th, 27th Feb & 28st March 2019.
- On the first Day of the workshop Adv.S.B.Sanap discussed issues on Women Empowerment. She discussed the need & importance and of the sensitive issue through practical examples.

- During second session Adv. IshaPatel made aware to girl students about the laws for them, use of laws & how to live with honor in society.

Disaster Management Training.

- The scheme is exclusively implemented for the Youth with the special focus on created awareness for emergency period, to encourage the students, youth to prevent the disastrous devastation made by natural calamities and manmade calamities. Minimize the devastation by implementing measures by implementing measures to overcome on disasters. The intention was to aware the students about pre & post disaster management. Under this scheme Two days Workshop was organized on 16th & 17nd Feb 2018.
- On first Day of the workshop Pravinkumar Patil has discussed issues on natural & manmade disasters at local level as well he threw light on national level, international level disasters. He compared the recent events held at local and national, inter-national level and their pre & post management of disasters through practical examples. He also discussed the use of ICT especially Remote Sensing and GIS in predicating of events.

- During second session Prof. K.S.Choudhari has discussed issues on biological disasters and biological activities like Ebola, Zica virus, swine flu, chicken guinea, AIDS/ HIV and tuberculosis with examples. He also discussed the preventive measures against the biological disasters.
- During the third session D.V.Sonawane has discussed the post management of disasters, How to minimize devastation, the preventive measures against the loss of lives and property with examples.
- On the second day Prof. D. K. kannor discussed the mental health issues and increasing health problems, mental imbalance problems. He discussed the causes, consequences and preventive measures on mental balancing.
