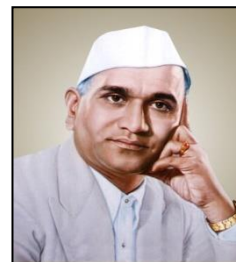

Board of Student Development Report 2022-2023

The Board of Student Development plays an integral role in the development of the college. It works as a mediator to communicate various Central and State Government and other schemes to the students. In the year 2022-2023, it has implemented several developmental schemes and programmes for the all-inclusive development of our college students. It has facilitated the participation of students in the intercollegiate and inter-University competitions. It has encouraged students for participating in Earn and Learn Scheme, Nirbhay Kanya Abhiyan and a seminar on Neo-Entrepreneurship and Business Opportunities. It has encouraged students for filling up scholarship forms for various university scholarship schemes. By organizing various events and programmes the Board has contributed to the overall development of the students.

The following schemes were implemented by the Board of Student Development in the academic year 2022-2023: -

- Karmaveer Bhaurao Patil Earn and Learn Scheme
- Nirbhay Kanya Abhiyan
- A Seminar on Neo-Entrepreneurship

➤ **Karmaveer Bhaurao Patil Earn and Learn Scheme**

The scheme avails job opportunities to the poor and the needy students in the college campus itself so that they may secure higher education without hurdles. Supporting financially weaker students and facilitating earning while learning is the special feature of the scheme. The scheme simultaneously focuses on the enhancement and maintenance of dignity of labour and creating work culture among students.

For the academic year 2022-2023 near about 20 students applied for the enrolment in Earn and Learn scheme. They were interviewed individually and enrolled in the scheme based on their financial status, skills and availability of jobs. Based on this, 10 students were enrolled and provided jobs as per the scheme. The students were provided jobs in various departments of the college. The major work was done in the Library, Office, Examination

section, and Garden. The works included- book arrangement and numbering, data entry and processing, record keeping, scanning of exam and scholarship forms, office management and helping respective departments in organizing various seminars, conferences and competitions. Students were given access to the computers which motivated computer literacy and other vocational skills.

➤ **Nirbhay Kanya Abhiyan**

The scheme is exclusively implemented for the girl students with special focus on developing personality and boosting the morale. Under this scheme a workshop was organized in the college on 27, and 28 February 2023.

- Eminent guests expert in their respective field were invited for the programme, which included doctor, advocates and trainers. The programme was inaugurated with the auspicious hands of respected **advocate, Isha Patel**. During the session Advocate Isha Patel, shared her views on women's issues and the legal provision for safeguarding their rights. She also spoke about the issues faced by women in domestic or social sphere and the ways to tackle such issues.
- Mr. Shrikant Waghchaure, the physical director, from D. Paul English Medium School who is a trainer of Judo-Karate delivered demonstrations of self-defence to female students. All the students enthusiastically participated in the activities.
- In the second day session Dr. Suresh Kambale spoke about women's health issues and changing life-style. He emphasized the need of healthy food and Yoga for healthy life. He also expressed the need of social health in the present day situation.
- The honourable principal of the college in his presidential speech spoke on the importance of healthy diet and exercise. He emphasized the need for traditional life style.
- Prof. Ramprasad Wavhal anchored the programme. Dr. Sharad Chavan, the Student Development Officer, introduced the aims and objectives of the programme, while Prof. Abhilasha Shinde presented vote of thanks.
- Around 120 students registered their participation in the programme. 03 female students from Muktanand Science College remained presents in the programme along with their representatives.

➤ **Neo-Entrepreneurship and Business Opportunities:**

On March 4, 2023, MGV's Arts and Commerce College organised a workshop on Neo-Entrepreneurship and Business Opportunities. The programme, organised under the board of student development, was intended to expose young generation to innovative ideas and knowledge of the business world. On this occasion, Dr. Devendrashing Thakor ex-HOD and research coordinator, department of Commerce, M. S. G. College, Malegaon camp and Prof. Ajinkya Patil from Arts and Commerce College, Yeola were invited as resource persons.

Prof Ajinkya Patil exposed students to new trends and opportunities in the business field. He also acquainted students to 'make in India' projects run by the central government and encouraged them to avail financial assistance from similar schemes. Dr. Devendrashing Thakor emphasised the need for persistent hard-work, devotion,

innovativeness, and professionalism. He reiterated the need for certain business ethics along with the quality to adjust oneself like 'water'. Prin. Dr. Bhausahab Game spoke about the need for discipline and self-confidence in his presidential speech.

Dr. D. T. Dhangar anchored the programme and the coordinator of BSD, Dr. Sharad Chavan introduced the aims and objectives of the programme. A large number of students attended the programme. The programme proved to be a huge success.

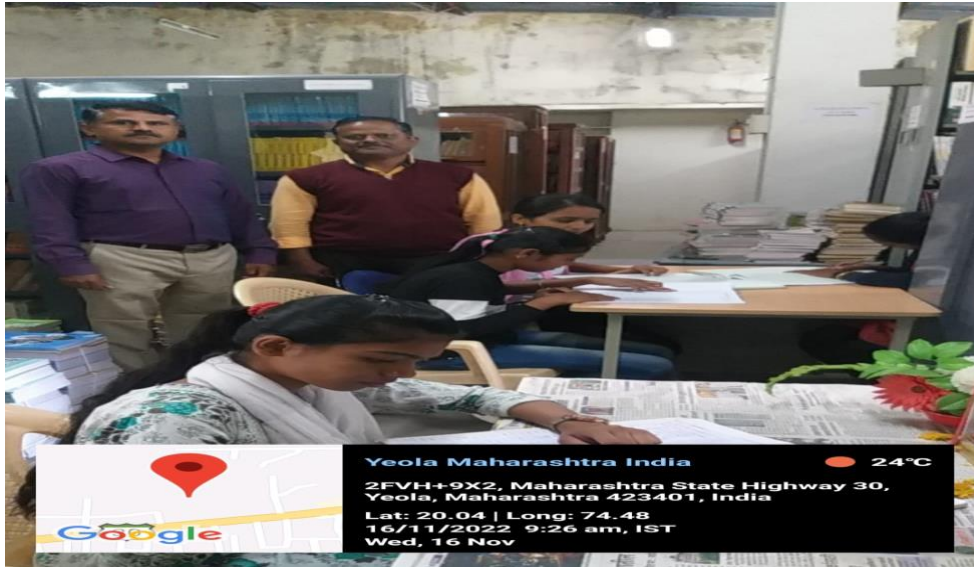

Nirbhay Kanya Abhiyan (2022-23)

Nirbhay Kanya Abhiyan is a woman centric programme which promotes personality development of female students. The programme organises various informative lectures on health issues, legal rights, social equality and other such topics which help to broaden perspectives and develop confidence of female students.

The programme was organized on 27 and 28 February 2023. Eminent resource persons were invited to deliver thought provoking and valuable guidance to our students. On the first day, Adv. Isha Patel inaugurated the programme and spoke about women's legal rights. The session was followed by demonstrations on self-defence. Mr. Shriant Waghchaure, the physical director and a judo-karate trainer, from D. Paul English Medium School guided students by delivering lessons of self-defence for female students. On the second day, Dr. Suresh Kambale delivered valuable information on women's health problem. He discussed on the problems arising from lack of haemoglobin, hormonal imbalance and problems related to menstrual cycle.

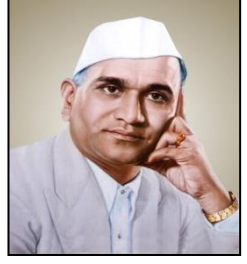


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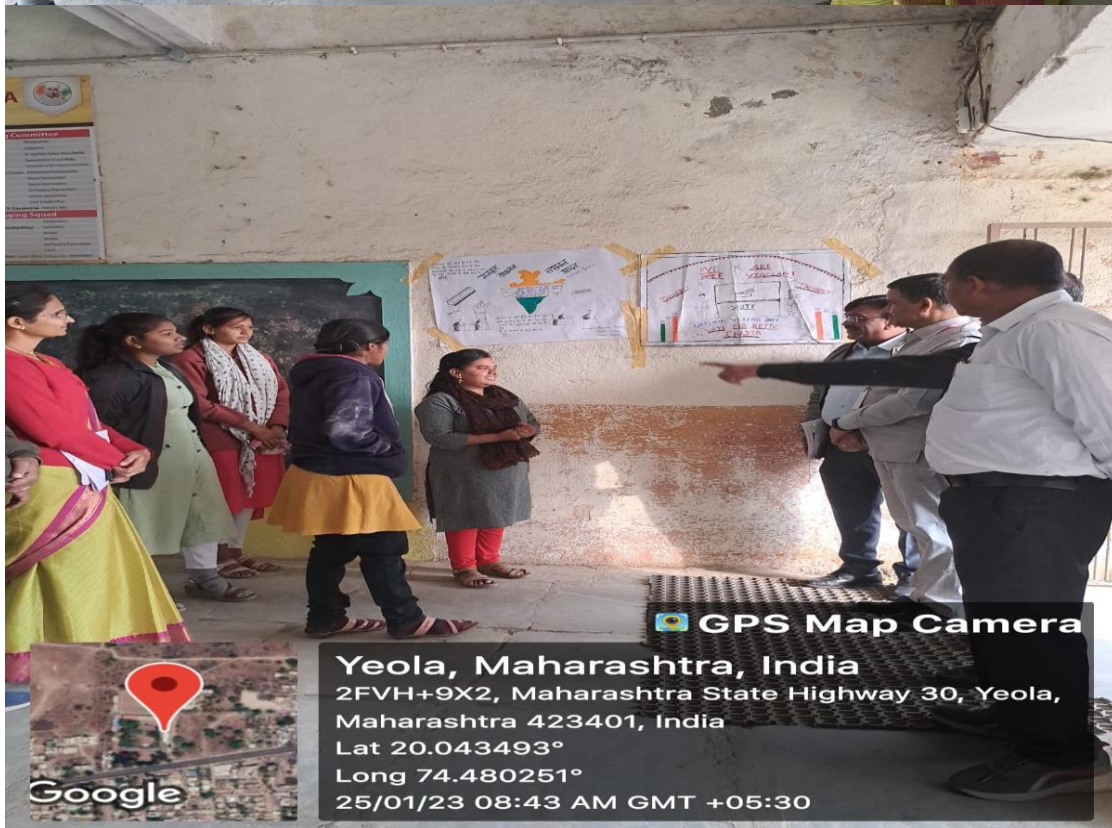
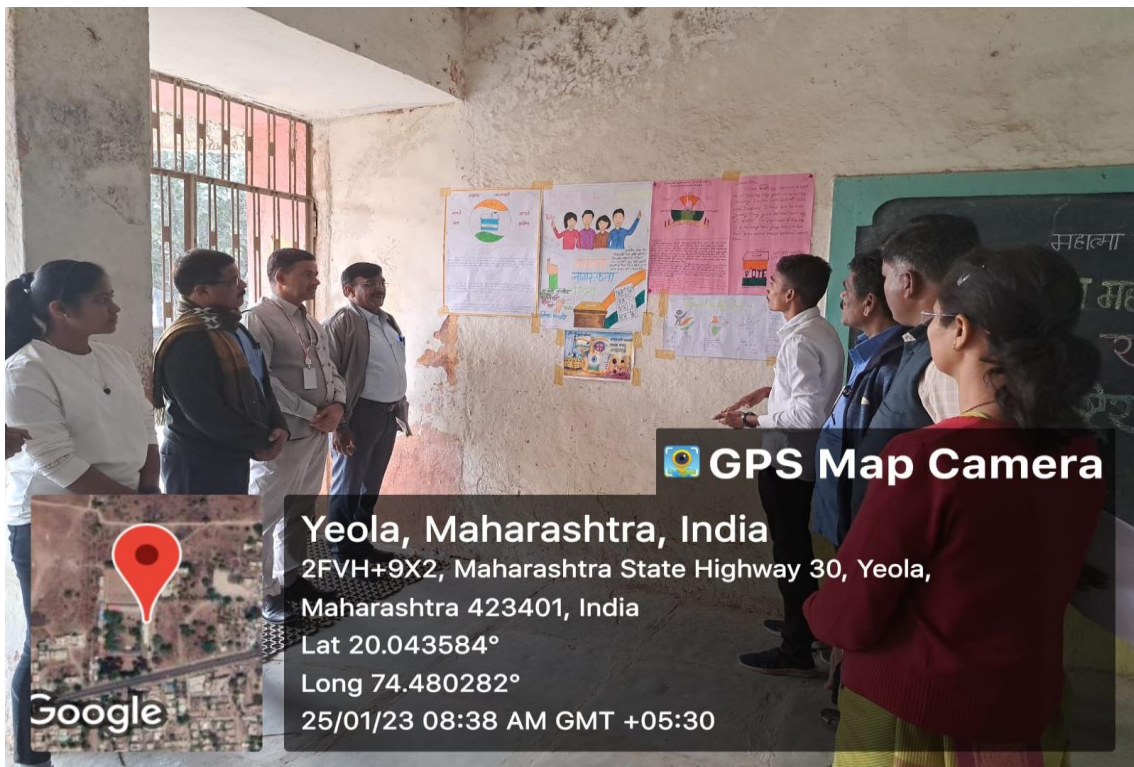
Celebration of Lokshahi Pandharwada/Voter's Day
