





#### **Constitution Day Celebration**

Mr. Samatadut Chandrakant Ingle, the Director of Babasaheb Ambedkar Research and Training Institute (BARTI, Pune), delivered a special lecture on the Indian Constitution, emphasizing the significance of adopting and embracing it. The lecture took place at Mahatma Gandhi Vidyamandir's Arts and Commerce College Yeola, with Prin. Dr Bhausaheb Game presiding over the event.

During the lecture, Mr. Ingle highlighted the importance of the constitution and its provisions. He elucidated the purpose of the Constitution and underscored that India's constitution is the finest in the world. He emphasized that the Constitution is built upon fundamental human values such as liberty, equality, justice, and fraternity, safeguarding the rights and well-being of individuals from all walks of life, from infants to the elderly, and from plants to animals.

Principal Dr Bhausaheb Game emphasized the need to internalize the Constitution's objectives, not just as printed words in a book but as engraved principles in the minds of students. He stressed the importance of studying the Constitution to find answers to unresolved societal issues. Dr Game also urged eligible students, who have turned eighteen, to register as voters, enabling them to actively participate in the democratic process.





#### **Indian Constitution and Rights for Equality**

Date: April 2023

#### Introduction:

The Department of Political Science at the Arts and Commerce College organized a special lecture on the "Form and Function of the Judicial System." The lecture featured senior jurist Jugalkishore Kalantri, who shed light on the significance of equality within the judiciary and its crucial role in society.
