आहे पण त्या मानाने उपलब्ध साधन संपत्ती कमी आहे. त्यामुळे प्राथमिक गरजाही जिथे पूर्ण होऊ शकत नाही तिथे अधिक गुणवत्तापूर्ण शिक्षण आणि कौशल्यपूर्ण शिक्षण घेऊनही हाताला काम मिळू शकत नाही, त्यास्तव आपण लक्षात

घ्यायला हवे, असे ते म्हणाले. वाढत्या लोकसंख्येबरोबरच व्यस्त लिंग गुणोत्तर हे देखील वितेचे कारण असल्याचे ते म्हणाले.

अध्यक्षीय मनोगतात प्राचार्य डॉ. गमे यांनी, आज जगाच्या आठशे कोटी लोकसंख्येपैकी

एकट्या भारताची लोकसंख्या एकशे बत्तीस कोटी असल्याचे सांगून ही चिंताजनक बाब असल्याचे नमूद केले. वाढत्या लोकसंख्येमुळे मोठ्या प्रमाणावर वाढणारे शहरीकरण, बेरोजगारी, गुन्हेगारी, भूक, उपसमार, गरीबी, आरोग्य या

समस्या वाढल्या आहेत. आज मुंबईची जी स्थिती झालेली आहे त्याला कारण तेथील वाढलेली लोकसंख्या हे असून उपलब्ध निवेशक कमी पडते आहे, असे ते म्हणाले. आता यापुढे 'हम दो, हमारा एक' अशी योजना राबवावी लागेल कारण वाढत्या लोकसंख्येला पुरेशा ठरतील, उच्च जीवनमान देऊ शकतील, अशा सोयीसुविधा आपल्याकडे उपलब्ध नसल्याचे ते म्हणाले.

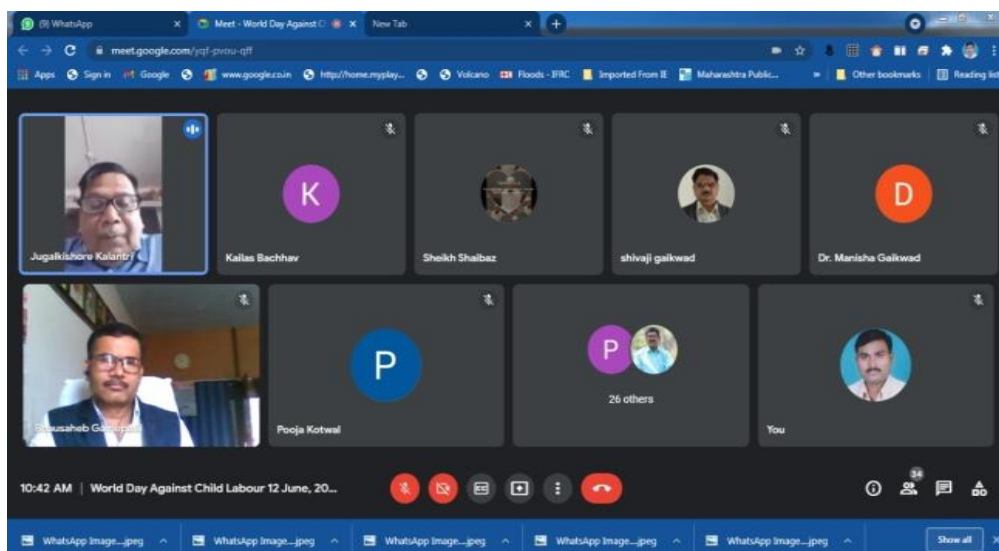
**Celebration of World Day against Child Labour

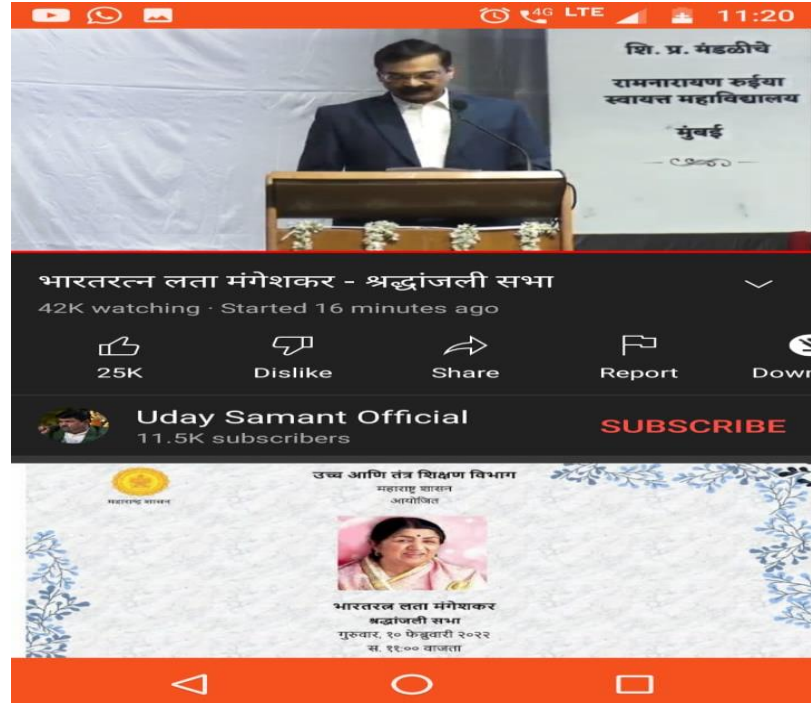


Condolence Programme (10 Feb. 2022)

Oral Cancer Diagnosis: Insights from Dr. Ganesh Wagh's Lecture

Date: October 24, 2018

On October 24, 2018, Mahatma Gandhi Vidyamandir's Arts and Commerce College Yeola hosted a health awareness program under the Sociology Board in commemoration of Samajshree Dr. Prashanthada Hiray's birthday. As part of the program, Dr. Ganesh Wagh, a dentist, delivered a lecture on 'oral cancer diagnosis and treatment'. The event was presided over by the college's principal, Dr. Bhausaheb Game.

During his presentation, Dr. Ganesh Wagh provided valuable insights into the causes, symptoms, diagnosis, and treatment of oral cancer. He emphasized that tobacco consumption and smoking are major risk factors for mouth cancer. Additionally, he pointed out that improperly emerging wisdom teeth, resulting in sharp friction, can also contribute to oral cancer. Dr. Wagh advised young individuals to stay away from harmful habits and encouraged them to raise awareness among rural communities, warning that even the consumption of misri (a type of sweetener) by women could lead to cancer.

Addressing the fear associated with cancer, Dr. Ganesh Wagh stressed that timely treatment without fear could lead to complete recovery. He urged everyone to maintain regular oral and dental care and emphasized the importance of consulting a doctor immediately if they notice painless mouth ulcers. To aid in the diagnosis of oral cancer, he highlighted the use of the OPG machine, which is available at Sai Multispeciality Dental Clinic even in rural areas, eliminating the need to travel to larger cities for diagnosis.

In his presidential address, Principal Dr. Bhausaheb Game commended the consistent efforts of the college in organizing health awareness programs. He emphasized that young boys should steer clear of addictive habits, while girls should also prioritize their health. Dr. Game highlighted the significance of the oral cancer lecture in prompting attendees to take care of their parents and others.

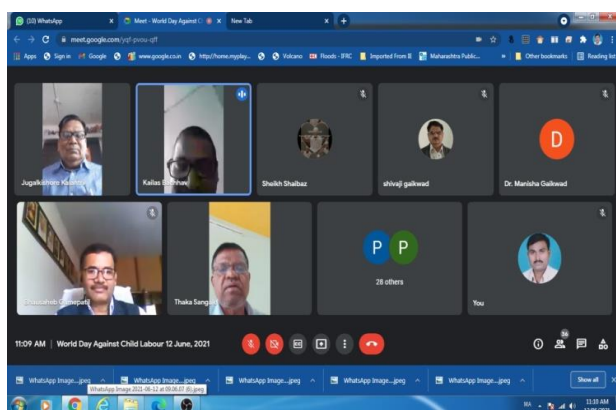
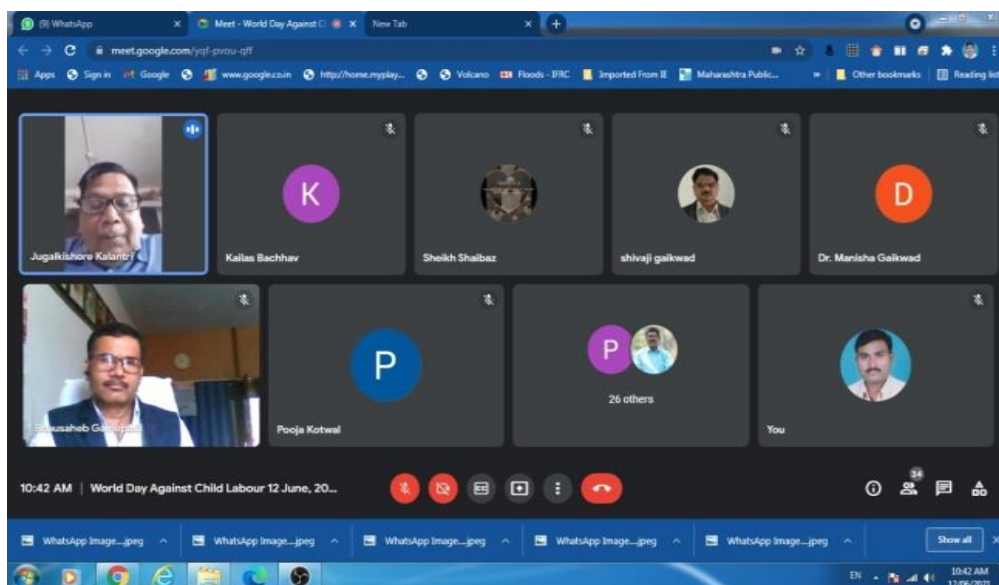
Celebration of World Day against Child Labour Report



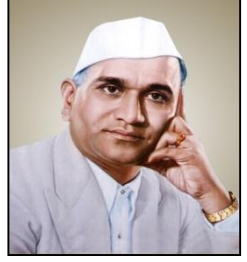
