A significant tree plantation week was organized from 24th to 30th July in collaboration with the National Service Scheme Department and Yevla Forest Department of Mahatma Gandhi Vidyamandir College of Arts and Commerce. A special lecture on environmental awareness was organized at Arts and Commerce College Yeola, under the guidance of Professor Rakesh Patil, emphasizing the importance of environmental protection and the need for action. The guest speaker highlighted that future generations will not forgive us if we fail to address this responsibility.

Dr Rakesh Patil, an expert in environmental studies, discussed the concept, nature, and scope of the environment. One of the major concerns he highlighted was the global rise in temperature, stating that a mere one-degree Celsius increase over ten years could endanger all life on Earth.

During the lecture, the students were informed about the efforts to control water pollution, air pollution, and noise pollution. Dr Patil also provided guidance on dealing with the on-going COVID-19 pandemic. He encouraged the students to engage in significant environmental conservation initiatives on an annual basis.

As a practical step towards environmental conservation, Dr Patil suggested that everyone should plant a tree and consider using eco-friendly transportation options such as the remote app for short distances, bicycles, or automated vehicles.

### **Environmental Protection: A Collective Responsibility**

Mahatma Gandhi Vidyamandir's Arts and Commerce College, Yeola organized a special lecture on the occasion of the birth anniversary of People's Leader Venkatarao Hiray and Vasundhara Day, focusing on the theme of 'Environment and Man.' Prof. Dr Ajay Vibhandik graced the event as the keynote speaker, while Principal Dr Bhausaheb Game presided over the program.

During his speech, Prof. Dr Ajay Vibhandik emphasized the significance of the environment. He highlighted how the environment has been the home of humanity for billions of years, evolving to support the existence of living beings on Earth. However, within a few years, human selfishness has caused immense damage to this environment. Prof. Vibhandik compared the condition of those who exploit the environment to the fictional character Sheikchilli, symbolizing foolishness. He emphasized that uncontrolled human behaviour has detrimental effects on the environment and poses a threat to human existence. Prof. Vibhandik advocated for embracing a simple and natural lifestyle to protect the environment, stating that true happiness lies in a pure and harmonious connection with nature rather than material wealth.

In his presidential address, Principal Dr Bhausaheb Game emphasized that true peace of mind, as advocated in spirituality, can only be attained through a close bond with nature. He urged everyone to adopt the message of the saints and align their desires with the well-being of the environment, acknowledging that justice to nature can only be achieved when human desires are minimized.

Vice Principal Shivajirao Gaikwad provided an introduction to the program, highlighting the relationship between the environment and human beings, as well as the work of People's Leader Venkatarao Hiray. 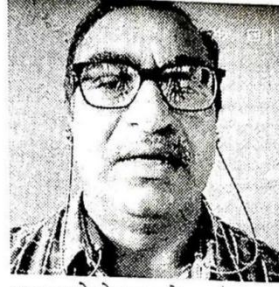
